Dress Code: Wear your favourite plaid! (Flannel, checkered, or tartan - let's see your best look!)




Pathways Office will be closed Tuesday, November 11th for Remembrance Day. Contact the on-call with any emergencies.

Telus World of Science Indigenous Learning Opportunities Northern Lights Indigenous Cultural Space

The Northern Lights Library, part of the Northern Lights Indigenous Cultural Space, in *The Nature Exchange* Gallery on the second level, is a place where Indigenous knowledge is woven with Western science. It features an interactive dreamcatcher created for the space by Ellie Lagrandeur, local Ojibwe artist. Guests can take a seat, relax and read a variety of books written by Indigenous authors about Indigenous stories across Turtle Island. This space is made to be a cozy, drop-in space where guests can learn on their own in a comfortable setting. Entry is included with Science Centre Admission.

Medicine Garden

The Medicine Garden is an outdoor space (located south of the Science Centre entrance) that is designed to follow the teachings of the Medicine Wheel. The Medicine Wheel can be broken up into four sections, each section representing the four directions, colours associated with the direction, and plants that generally grow in that direction.

Saulteaux


