
This bursary has been set up in honor of Pathways Foster Parent Leah Sorenson who believed, like Pathways, that all children deserve the opportunity to grow and improve.

Pathways has set up an annual \$500.00 bursary in Leah's name to allow any child who lives within our homes to apply for the bursary. Pathways must make this payment on behalf of the child or an original receipt must be provided.

Eligibility:

- Must be between the ages of 6-18.
- Must be residing within a licensed Pathways home.
- Must provide proof of enrollment and submit an original receipt.
- Completed Application form.
- Two reference letters from individuals who support your activity.
- 200-400 word statement or essay on why you would like this bursary.

Applications must be received by August 31st and the award will be announced by September 30th. The recipient(s) essay or statement will be shared at the annual Foster Parent Appreciation Banquet. The recipient(s) will be invited to join the event and if comfortable read their words aloud.
